Andy Stern is President of Service Employees International Union (SEIU). His unconventional approach to labor organizing has led to the unprecedented growth of SEIU against a backdrop of great labor union declines. Unafraid of change and undaunted by challenge, Stern's broad thinking has put him at the forefront of public policy debate.

At his core, Stern is a believer in the dignity of work, the worth of the American worker, and an advocate for economic fairness and justice. If he ran the world, there is no doubt he would slice the American Pie differently, but there would still be plenty of corporate profits to compensate CEO's and to ensure shareholder profits.

In his words: “The American economy is not a zero-sum game. There is no good moral or economic reason why all workers cannot or should not share in the success and prosperity they helped create. We need to restore the promise of the American Dream. And that means choosing what kind of country we want to be.”
