## My daughter paid a big price for someone's cheap illegal labor. And he'd like his driver's license back

Jose Rosario Mendez Lopez is one of Oregon's allegedly indispensable illegal workers. One night he sexually assaulted my elder daughter after following her into the women's locker room at a Portland area stable where they both worked. If he escapes deportation after his release in 2014, he would like to get a new drivers license. Illegal aliens need them to compete for jobs against our own minorities, legal immigrants, and entry level citizens.
